



Private Prescription Clinic (LDN) Costs (2024 onwards)

At Dickson Chemist we are committed to keeping the price of obtaining LDN very low and affordable for everyone. In order to be transparent, please find a price chart and explanation.

| COST | Where does it go | Outcome |

| £50 initial consultation for LDN | To the prescriber who completes the consultation with you. | You have paid for the prescriber to assess your condition, make sure LDN is safe for you and to write a prescription for up to 3 months. A prescription is an order to allow you to purchase LDN. It does not include the actual medicine itself. |
| LDN Drug Cost (subject to change with markets) <i>Costs for average month supply</i> £24 Liquid £29.50 Sublingual £33 Capsules | This pays for the medicine itself, the postage to get it to you, the packaging materials required, the time it takes the dispensers to make/dispense and the pharmacist to check it. | LDN Medicine is delivered to your home. (Can also be collected in store) |
| Repeat Fee £30 3 months £55 6 months | This goes to the clinician reviewing your case and forms part of the legal requirement for supplying an unlicensed medicine meeting an unmet need. | At the end of the review, they write another 3 or 6 month prescription and you can then order more LDN. NB: You can only request repeat prescriptions for 6 months once you have been stable on LDN for 6 months. |
| £50 follow up consultation fee | To the prescriber who is in charge of your care | This can be booked if something significant has changed, or you need to have a long conversation about multiple issues with your prescribing clinician in protected time |

There are generally no extra fees unless you are abroad and need your LDN sent via courier to another country, or rushed for next day delivery.
